

The Arvada Center Reaching for the Arts Scholarship Program

The Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities offers classes, workshops and camps in the areas of Drama, Dance, Visual Arts and Music. We offer classes in four sessions per year and accept scholarship applications prior to each session of classes. Scholarship awards are given for either full or partial tuition.

Scholarship Awards

Scholarships are available for all ages, children through adults, and are awarded in recognition of financial need and talent. Selections for scholarship awards are made through review of applications and submitted letters of recommendation.

Scholarships will be awarded for full or partial tuition with an emphasis being made on full scholarship awards. Scholarship grants are to be applied toward one class, workshop or camp and must be used for the session(s) for which they are granted.

Students receiving awards will be given a certificate and should register for the class, workshop or camp at the Box Office immediately upon receiving their certificate as some classes have limited availability.
